

## 2" fringe hemmed Single layer fleece blanket directions

You will need...

...1 &  $\frac{1}{2}$  to 2 yards of a single layer fleece  
Please use "Blizzard" or "Anti-Pill" fleece.

(please do not use "make-it and give it kits"—fabric too thin)  
(please do not use "happy value fleece"—fabric too thin)

...Sharp fabric scissors, ruler or tape measure,  
pins, sewing machine

**Step 1:** Using sharp scissors, cut off both selvage edges along

the length of the fleece.

The selvage edge sometimes has words printed on it.

Selvage edges may seem "hidden" and not obvious.

Look for small holes the length of the fabric.

The trimmed edge should be straight and smooth

(Fabric rolls, does not look nice if the selvage is left on)



**Step 2:** Cut a  $3 \frac{3}{4}$  inch square out of each corner of the fleece.

**Step 3:**

Fold & pin a 2 inch hem all around the blanket.

**\*\*Be sure to overlap the fabric at the corners.**




**Step 4:** Using a very wide zigzag stitch, from the wrong side of the fabric, stitch over the raw edge to hem the blanket.

**\*\* be sure to back stitch at all corners to reinforce**

**Step 5:** Cut 1 inch wide fringes around the blanket.

**\*\*Be careful –don't cut through the stitching.**



**Step 6:** Slit the fringes open at the fold.
